  - Make this monitoring report available to the Executive Committee.
  - Responsible for producing Calls for Projects for themes selected by the Executive Committee.
  - Publish Calls for [Participatory Research](#) Projects on specific themes on OSI's institutional website.
- **Implementation and/or Follow-up Format:**
  - Collective monitoring by each of you through postings on the forum on this page.
  - The individual in charge of this desk compiles a summary to present to the Executive Committee (in charge of the Program Committee) at any time during the year, and at a minimum during the annual Program Committee.
  - When a theme is selected by the Executive Committee, an update message is posted on the discussion thread in the forum that suggested this theme.
  - When a Call for Projects is published, an update message is posted on the discussion thread in the forum that suggested this theme, and the thread is marked as resolved and closed.
- **Response Timeframe:** Maximum 30 days
- **Production Timeframe After Consideration:**
  - Summary: Maximum 3 days
  - Selection: After Executive Committee meeting
  - Call for Projects if selected: between 30 and 90 days maximum
