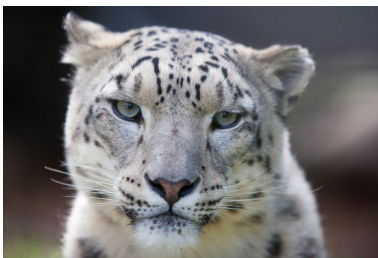

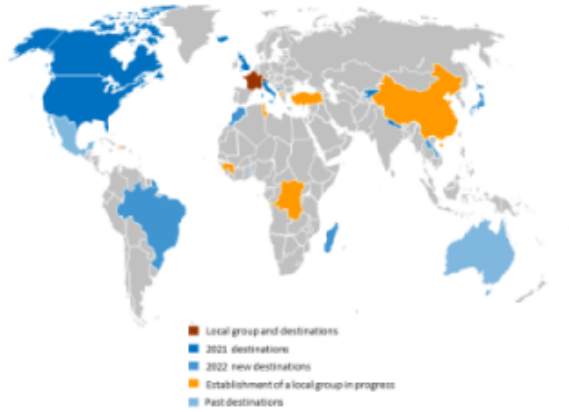

Project examples

Panthera expeditions: on the tracks of the Snow leopard

Goal : inventory Snow leopards and study their habits, repartition and behaviour

Location : Kyrgyzstan (Natural reserves of Sarychat-Ertash and Naryn, in the Pamirs Alai area), Nepal (as of 2019)

Main results : census of Snow leopard individuals in the surveyed areas (photographic and genetic traps), faunal and ornithological inventories

First expedition : 2006

Local collaborations and impact : collaboration with local guides, rangers, interpreters, etc., actors in the protection of the Snow leopards, sponsorship of local children

International collaborations : CNRS (DNA analysis), Panthera US, Snow Leopard Trust, Global Snow Leopard and Snow Leopard Network.

Project examples

A l'Affut de la Biodiversité On the lookout for biodiversity

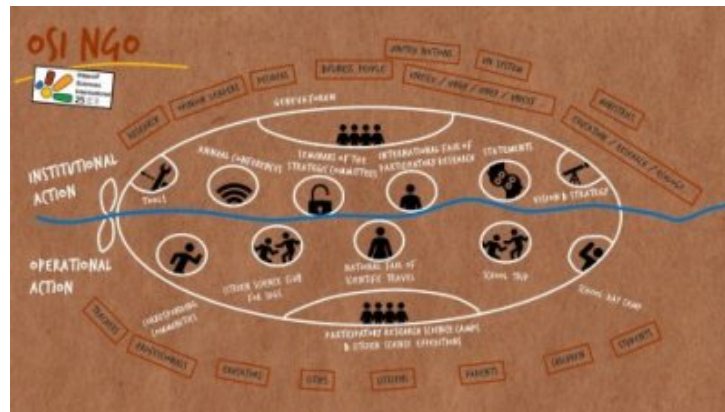
Goal : study the evolution of the biodiversity, in an alpine valley, with regard to climate change and the natural return of the wolf

Where : Switzerland, val d'Anniviers

Main results : census of 781 species, establishment of quantitative monitoring

First camp : 2014

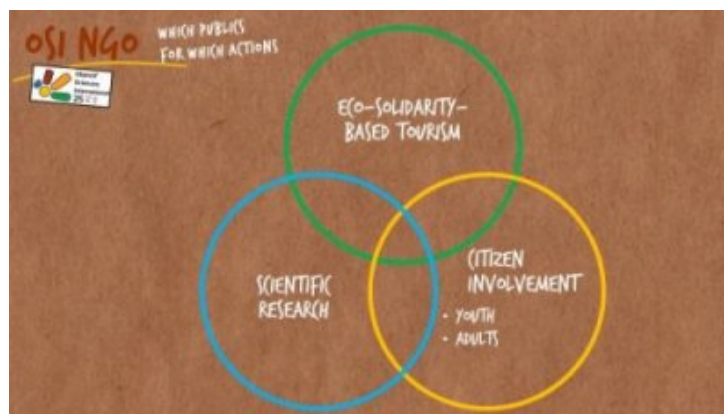
Local collaborations and impact : creation of animal and plant identification tools for the val d'Annivier residents and data supply for cantonal and national atlases
